AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE ACQUISITION AND PURCHASE OF TWO (2) SEWER GRINDERS FOR THE PUMP STATION LOCATED AT INDUSTRIAL AVENUE AND ROUTE 46 WEST FOR THE CAPITAL NEEDS OF THE BOROUGH'S DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$95,000.00 TO PAY THE COST THEREOF, IN THE BOROUGH OF TETERBORO, COUNTY OF BERGEN AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Teterboro that:

1. The acquisition and purchase of two (2) Sewer Grinders for the capital needs of the Borough's Department of Public Works is hereby authorized and the sum of \$95,000.00 is hereby appropriated on account of said purpose, which sum is available by virtue of the Capital Improvement Fund.

2. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith, and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital programs as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, are on file with the Borough Clerk and are available for public inspection.

3. This ordinance shall take effect when passed and published as required by law.
