AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH YEAR 2026 SALARY RANGES IN, BY AND FOR THE BOROUGH OF TETERBORO, COUNTY OF BERGEN AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Teterboro, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION I: COMPENSATION – CLASSIFICATION

If the provisions of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision or clause of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction such judgment shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of this Ordinance but such judgment shall be confined in its operation to the section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision or clause directly involved in the controversy in which said judgment shall have been rendered.
